
# Village of Hammond Housing Snapshot

#### **Housing Summary (2020 U.S. Census):**

- The mix of occupied housing units in the Village of Hammond is 26% Rental / 74% Owner.
- There is a need for additional rental units in the Village with a rental vacancy rate of 3.4%.
- There is a need for additional owner units in the Village with an owner vacancy rate of 0.5%.
- Less than 0.3% of the Village's housing stock is for seasonal, recreational, or occasional use.



- 5% of Village of Hammond's residents who are employed have a primary job inside the Village while 95% leave the Village for work.
- 62% of the Village's workforce lives in St. Croix County, with 9% in Pierce County, 4% in Dunn County, with the remainder in other counties.


### **Additional Local Housing Information:**


- The Village reported 5 single-family units, constructed from 2020 to June 2024.
- The Village has a multi-use Tax Increment
  District that includes residential development.
- The median sale price for housing in the St. Croix Central School District increased 14% between 2022 and 2024, from \$335,500 in 2022 to \$382,500 in 2024.

- Total population has increased about 62% over the last 20 years.
- The median age in the Village increased 2 years from 2000 to 2020.
- There is a growing number of smaller households in the Village. In 2000, 31% of households were comprised of one person while in 2020 this percentage increased to 38%.
- The owner and renter vacancy rates within the Village are below the healthy ranges.
- The Village experienced a 99% growth in single-family units and a 220% increase in mobile homes from 2000 to 2020.
