
# Village of Star Prairie Housing Snapshot

#### **Housing Summary (2020 U.S. Census):**

- The mix of occupied housing units in the Village of Star Prairie is 28% Rental / 72% Owner.
- There is a slight need for additional rental units in the Village with a rental vacancy rate of 4.8%.
- There is a strong need for additional owner units in the Village with an owner vacancy rate of 0.0%.
- About 0.3% of the Village's housing stock is for seasonal, recreational, or occasional use.



- 1% of Village of Star Prairie's residents who are employed have a primary job inside the Village while 99% leave the Village for work.
- 66% of the Village's workforce lives in St. Croix County, with 12% in Polk County, 6% in Washington County (MN), with the remainder in other counties.





- Total population has increased about 18% over the last 20 years.
- The median age in the Village increased 6 years from 2000 to 2020.
- There is a decline in the number of households with individuals under 18 in the Village. In 2000, nearly 40% of households had at least one individual under 18, while in 2020 this percentage decreased to 31%.
- The owner vacancy rate is significantly below the healthy range, while the renter vacancy rate is 0.2% below the healthy range.
- The Village experienced a 50% growth in single-family units and a 94% increase in 2+ units from 2000 to 2020.
